2017 Health Plan Contribution Rates

- ❖ Medicare Supplement Plan: 9% Increase
- ❖ No change to Medical co-insurance or deductibles
- ❖ No change to Pharmacy co-pays
- ❖ 4% Increase to Dental Plan
- ❖ No change to Vision Plan

Pharmacy Plan Trend Components

- ✓ Comprises 3/4s of annual contribution rate
- ✓ Annual Inflation – app. 2%
- ✓ Claims costs increased 15% from '14 to '15
 - ✓ Increase of 14% is projected for 2017
- ✓ Specialty Drugs
 - ✓ 30% of overall Plan costs
 - ✓ 118 unique specialty members
- ✓ Cost Savers
 - ✓ Average Wholesale Price Discounts
 - ✓ Brand drugs losing patent protection
 - ✓ Church Benefit Association Coalitions

Eligibility for Opposite Gender Domestic Partners

- Coverage begins on January 1, 2017
- Applications accepted beginning November 1st, 2016
- Enrollment guidelines:
 - relationship has been in effect for at least 6 months
 - documentation of financial interdependence
- Relationships of less than 6 months: enroll upon completion of 6 month anniversary

International Travel Coverage

- As of January 1, 2017, the Medicare Supplemental Plan will no longer provide coverage for medical (physician and hospital) services obtained while travelling overseas, to include travel on cruise ships.
- Plan participants can choose to apply for travel insurance offered by:
 - a travel agency; AARP, AAA, the airline or cruise carrier
- Travelers may wish to consider Faith Ventures Travel Services, a travel services company, for optional travel coverage to include:
 - Medical coverage
 - Travel assistance
 - Discounted airfares through Fly For Good

Preventive Dental Exams

- Dental Plan participants are eligible annually for two no-cost preventive exams and cleanings with a participating United Concordia Dentist
 - Approximately 25% of dental plan participants do not use this annual benefit
 - Schedule an appointment with your dental provider to take advantage of this no-cost benefit which is included in your dental coverage.
- Contact United Concordia for assistance locating a Network provider.

Hearing Aid Benefit

- Benefit provides a per person allowance of \$3,000 every three (3) years (see brochure)
- No enrollment or application is needed; the benefit is included under your health plan coverage
- To maximize your benefit, use an in-network Blue Cross Blue Shield provider
- The provider's office will verify coverage with Highmark Blue Cross at 866.763.9471
- Cost of warranties is not covered
- Please contact the Pension Boards with any questions

Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan

- Our Pharmacy Plan follows Medicare coverage and formulary guidelines
- The benefit is administered by Express Scripts
- Coverage appeals are reviewed by Express Scripts
- Two Plans are offered (see brochure)
 - Standard
 - Value
- Medical & Pharmacy benefits are combined in Plan offering
 - Can only have one Part D Pharmacy Plan
